On January 14, 2019 MPD responded to a local restaurant for a report of a suspicious circumstance. An employee at the location reported that a white male adult dressed in red came into their store and placed a baggy of meth underneath a napkin dispenser. After the suspect male left, a mom and her 3 year old sat down at the table and the 3 year old found the baggy of meth and picked it up. The child's mother quickly took it from the child and gave it to restaurant employees. A short time later, two suspects came in and started checking all of the napkin dispensers looking for the baggy of meth.
