Jackson County Sheriff's Office and Crime Stoppers of Southern Oregon need your help locating a man with a felony warrant and a history of domestic violence. John Martin Phelan, 64, was released from jail on December 11, 2017, after serving his sentence for assaulting his ex-girlfriend. In the week following his release, deputies say Phelan contacted the victim twice, violating the terms of his probation. The district attorney's office filed a motion to revoke Phelan's probation; a judge granted the motion and signed a felony arrest warrant.

Phelan was last seen in Medford on December 18, 2017. Phelan has been known to frequent the White City area. He is reportedly transient and relies on public transportation and hitchhiking to get around. Phelan is five feet, eleven inches tall and weighs 220 pounds. He has gray hair and green eyes.
