Crime Stoppers and Medford Police are asking for the public's help solving the mentioned crimes involving high end electric bicycles.

18-18045 Theft 1 (Motorized Bicycle)

LOCATION: Barnes and Noble, 1400 Biddle Road

DATE/ TIME: 09/06/18 @ 1200hrs

The victim advised he rides his electric bike every day to Starbucks every day. He said about 10 min prior to the call, someone cut the cable lock on his bike and left with it. The victim reported the bike was secured in a bike rack in front of Barnes and Noble. The bike is described as a red Wind Runner and is valued at \$2,199.

18-18294 Burglary I / Theft I

LOCATION: 97 Windsor Ave.

DATE/ TIME: 09/09/18 @ 1850 hours

An unknown suspect entered the victim's attached garage and stole a motorized bicycle valued at over \$4,000.00. The bicycle is described as a black and green Bulls Evo motorized bicycle.

DATE/ TIME: 09/02/18 @ 1818 hours

The victim reported that she had a \$2,800 Specialized electric bicycle taken from her garage. She found the rollup door open, but believes that she had closed it prior to bed. The bike is described as a black Specialized men's electric bike.
