JACKSON COUNTY, Ore. – Jackson County Sheriff’s Office deputies are trying to identify a group of suspects seen on surveillance video using a stolen debit card. The card was lost or stolen in late August 2018 and used for about a week before the elderly victim noticed the theft.

Between August 27 and September 6, the suspects used the card at several restaurants and stores. Most of the charges were made in the downtown and south Medford area. The total amount of unauthorized charges exceeds \$1500.

The suspects appear to be three men and one woman. They are associated with a black Dodge pickup, approximately model year 2000, with a white camper shell.
