BALLOT MEASURES:

In principle, the Jackson County Republican Party opposes increased or new taxes of any kind. However, we also believe in local control in these decisions. We are not recommending for or against individual measures.

15-158 – Jackson County Fire District 4. Imposes 4 Year Levy to continue funding four firefighter/EMT paramedic positions currently funded by two-year FEMA grant expiring this year. Would impose \$0.99 per \$1,000 of assessed value for those in Fire District 4.

15-169 – Rogue River School District. If passed would qualify district for matching \$3,335,000 matching state grant. Bond would pay to upgrade heating, ventilation/ac systems, deferred maintenance, including asbestos removal & site imps including energy saving, ADA compliance, equipping/bonding costs.

15-170 – City of Talent. Imposes a 3¢/gallon tax on diesel fuel sold within the Talent City limits to pay for construction, reconstruction, improvement, repair and maintenance and operation of Talent City streets. **JCRP Comment:** This could put diesel gas businesses in Talent at a distinct disadvantage as they would most likely have to raise their prices 3¢/gallon.
