Jackson County Sheriff's Office deputies are looking for a 26-year-old woman with multiple felony warrants. Kierstin Ashli Michaels (AKA King) is wanted for violating her probation on original charges of possession of meth and heroin. Michaels is reportedly associated with Devon James Wright, a burglary and menacing suspect arrested by deputies in Butte Falls on February 3.

Michaels is five feet, two inches tall and weighs 100 pounds. She has long blond hair and blue eyes.

Michaels has been known to frequent different areas of Jackson County. Deputies believe she recently spent time in Butte Falls, Medford, and White City.
