BUSINESS BURGLARIES FOUR (4) BURGLARIES –TARGETING CONSTRUCTION TOOLS

The below crimes occurred during over the weekend of Friday, December 7th to Sunday December 9th, 2018, in Medford Oregon. Late evening –early morning hours.

4 adult Hispanic males burglarized 2 construction equipment rental businesses, a construction business, and a tractor equipment sales business. Total loss over \$50,000. The suspects are organized and appeared experienced.

Suspects cut cyclone fencing to enter area of businesses and cut through roll up door, remove window in door or force entry. Suspects used cordless drill, long pry bar, bolt cutters and tin snips. 3 suspects force entry while another stays with vehicles.

2 vehicles were used.
