JACKSONVILLE, Ore. – Jackson County Sheriff’s Office (JCSO) deputies are hoping someone can help identify a man seen on surveillance video using a stolen credit card. The card was taken from a rural mailbox just west of Jacksonville.

The stolen card was used at four different businesses in Jacksonville and Medford on April 20, 2019. Unauthorized charges totaled nearly \$900 before the fraud was reported on April 22.

Deputies were later able to obtain surveillance footage from the Chevron gas station in Jacksonville, where the card was used to purchase items. From the photos, the suspect appears to be a white male adult with brown hair and a brown and grey beard. He was wearing a black coat with orange trim, a blue shirt, dark blue Adidas pants, and red or orange athletic shoes.
